Generics Cost a Lot Less Under Your Welfare Fund benefits

Did you know?

- Under your Welfare Fund benefits, you can get a prescription filled for as little as \$2 when you use a generic medication.
- Brand-name drugs cost an average of six times more than generic drugs.
- Generic drugs have the same dosage, strength and effectiveness as their brand-name equivalents and must meet U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) standards.



| Drug Type | Retail (up to a 30-day supply) | Mail-Order (up to a 90-day supply) |
|-----------------------|--------------------------------------|--|
| Generic | \$2.00 copay | \$5.00 copay |
| Multi-source brand | \$50.00 copay | \$125.00 copay |

Ask your doctor about generic alternatives whenever medications are prescribed for you. If there is one that's right for you, it could lead to big savings—for YOU and for the Welfare Fund!
